ORDER

WHEREAS, Government College of Teacher Education, Thalassery – 67-1-1, Kerala was granted recognition for the conduct of B.Ed course of one year duration from the academic session 2001-2002 with an annual intake of 88 students on 31/10/2001.

AND WHEREAS, further, the conditional recognition accorded to Government College of Teacher Education, Thalassery, Kerala for the conduct of M.Ed course on 22.06.2007 was withdrawn vide this office order dated 23.09.2009. The institution has approached the Hon'ble High Court of Kerala at Ernakulam and the matter is pending in the Hon'ble Court.

AND WHEREAS, on 18.03.2014, the Principal, Govt. Brennen College of Teacher Education, has submitted a request for inclusion of the new name (i.e Govt. Brennen College of Teacher Education) vide letter dated 17.03.2014 which is as under :-

"Govt. College of Teacher Education, Thalassery, Kannur, Kerala has been renamed as Govt. Brennen College of Teacher Education, Thalassery as per Govt. of Kerala order G.O(Rt) No. 1399/08/H.Edn dated 20.09.2008 and G.O(Rt) No. 1675/08/H.Edn dated 10.11.2008 and the University of Kannur also approved the renaming of the institution as per order U.O.No. Acad.AI/GBCTE/10278/2008 dated 10.03.2009 (orders attached). I humbly request you to take necessary steps to include the new name in your future correspondence and give a letter effecting the change.

The delay in sending this letter from NCTE has resulted in the NAAC accreditation process of the college coming to a standstill."

AND WHEREAS, the Southern Regional Committee in its 266th meeting held on 2nd May, 2014 considered the matter, decided and advised Southern Regional Office to write to the lawyer again to report the present position of the case; and, to move the Court for dismissing the petition While considering the letter from the advocate in respect of the Court case filed by the institution (M.Ed Course) SRC in its 273rd Meeting held during 30th September and 1st October, 2014 considered the matter and decided as under :-

1. Our order, confirmed in appeal has not been interfered with by the Court.
2. Ask NAAC how they have entertained their application not with standing our order.
3. The institution is reported to be admitting students irregularly in spite of our order. Ask the University to take adverse notice and withdraw affiliation.
4. In the circumstances, their request for change of name cannot be considered.
